To locate and note non-timber values in the Forest Management District 15 area.

Description

Forest management needs to consider a broader range of social values and this project is a first step in spatially identifying where other values might need to be considered. From a questionnaire conducted, the majority of people interviewed did their activities for pleasure in areas that are scenic and close to home. The final maps generated are generally accurate and reflect the variety of overall uses of the Forest Management District 15 area. It is hoped that Corner Brook Pulp and Paper can use this information to better accommodate other forest values in this area.
